Patrol Award Rules for Season 2017-18

Patrol Person of the Year Award

Outstanding contribution by a member in the delivery of Surf Life Saving services to the club, and community, above and beyond the requirements of membership.

- Nominations to be made by Patrol Captains, and the Club Captain and Vice-Captain.
- Short list developed by selection committee (nominally the Club Captain and Vice Captain).
- Selection Committee may choose to interview short listed candidates to help with selection.
- Suggestion of winner provided to Club Executive for final review and decision.

The successful recipient of Patrol Person of the year will be Awarded at the Club Presentation Night, and will be extended an invitation to the Club's Annual Ski Trip.

100% Patrol Attendance Award.

Patrol 100% of rostered hours, without change or substitution.

- Must complete all rostered hours.
- Must be 100% in accordance with the roster (not start late or leave early).
- Must have complied with all other Patrol Rules and guidelines.

The successful recipients of 100% Patrol Attendance Award will be Awarded at the Club Presentation Night, and will be extended an invitation to the Club's Annual Ski Trip.

Outstanding Patrol Attendance Award.

Complete 100% of rostered hours, other than 1 patrol shift where the member obtained a substitute, and made up the hours.

- Must have arranged substitute and advised the Patrol Captain in advance.
- 'Make up' hours must be completed as Substitute Patrol hours or hours on the two 'Voluntary Patrols' weekends (Senior State and Aussies weekends).

The successful recipients of Outstanding Patrol Attendance Award will be Awarded at the Club Presentation Night, and may be extended an invitation to the Club's Annual Ski Trip [subject to availability after Patrol Person of the Year and 100% Patrol Attendance Award, and Winning Patrol recipients are consulted].
